Woodford Post 67, American Legion, Veterans Banner Program is to honor our hometown veterans. This Banner Program has been accepted by both the city of Versailles and the city of Midway.

Both cities have agreed to place the banners in their rotation of holiday banners. The cities have full discretion as to when the banners are hung. One city may choose to hang the banners while the other does not for a particular holiday. In the event that there are more banners than available hanging spots, they will be rotated for the next hanging so all banners are hung an equal number of times.

Service Verification

A copy of the veteran's DD-214 or NGB Form 22 service document is required. The veteran for which the banner is request must have been Honorably Discharged from military service. You must select one of the statements below.

- _____ a. Provide a copy of veteran's service document if it has not already been provided to Woodford Post 67 (see b, c, and d below).
- _____ b. If you are a veteran and a member of Woodford Post 67 your service document has already been verified and is not required again.
- _____ c. If you are a member of the Sons of the American Legion Squad 67 or the American Legion Auxiliary Unit 67, and are requesting a banner for the same person your membership is held under, the service document has already been verified and is not required again.
- _____ d. If the veteran you are honoring is a Gold Star Veteran and their name is listed on the memorial in front of the courthouse in Versailles their service has already been vetted and documentation is not required again.

Note: A DD-214 or NGB Form 22 can be obtained through the Department of Military Affairs. You can get the form at <https://www.va.gov/records/get-military-serive-records/>. There is no cost and the turnaround is quick.

Photograph

Provide a clear SERVICE photograph of the veteran being honored with a 300 DPI image. We make a reasonable and earnest attempt to work with any high-quality photograph.

Photos cannot be returned. Please do not send your only copy of a photograph with this application.

Cost

Midway banners: \$ 48.65

Versailles banner: \$ 79.12

The cost difference in the banners is the size that hangs in each city.

Documents

All documents and the photo must be assembled in the same packet to be accepted into the program. Partial or piecemeal applications will not be accepted. Required documents are:

1. Completed application.
2. DD-214 or NGB Form 22 if one is not already on file. Please provide a copy, not the original.
3. Photograph of the veteran in uniform. No photocopies please.
4. Payment in full.

Application Deadline

Deadline for submitting applications is April 30, 2026.

Woodford Post 67 reserves the right to halt taking applications at such time as they deem the project to have reached capacity. A quick response with the required documents is your best chance to participate in the program for this year.

Terms and Conditions

The quality of banners is good for several years but due to exposure to the elements and other variables, they will not last forever. At such time as they are retired, a reasonable effort to return the banner to the sponsor, based on the information in this application, will be made.

The Banner Program currently has more banners than the number of spaces for hanging. Due to the number of banners on hand, they will be displayed on a rotation basis by the city of Versailles and the city of Midway. Woodford Post 67 bears no responsibility of how often or the length of time the banners are displayed but will ensure they are hung on a rotating basis.

If, at some point, you no longer wish for the veteran's banner to participate in the program, it will be returned to you. However, once it's withdrawn from the program, it cannot be returned for future display.

It is suggested you keep a copy of this application so you may refer to the terms and conditions at a later date if necessary.
